On take off, after a slight initial swing to starboard, the aircraft started to swing to port. The pilot corrected this swing with engines and rudder, but a violent swing to starboard followed which he could not correct. Remarks

A Court of Inquiry has been convened to determine the cause of this accident but it appears that the pilot may have opened up the throttles too quickly for his take off and may have overcorrected the swing instead of abandoning the take off and starting again.
